10	Painting – portrait, still life and landscapes (bonus points for Maidenhead related!)

Junior – 16 years old and under

11	Make a vegetable animal
12	Best decorated Pumpkin
13	Make a collage from found materials
14	Any other craft – including sewing and woollen crafts

Judging Criteria:

All entries to be judged on originality, use of materials and technique.

Adult:

15	An item of clothing
16	Homeware item – including quilting and patchwork
17	Needlework - including embroidery, cross stitch, needlepoint

Judging Criteria: Entries will be marked out of 10 possible points on each of the following:

- Presentation, overall appearance
- Degree of difficulty
- Craftsmanship, skill, and technique
- Style, design, creativity, and originality
- Finish, use of colour, and material

For a total of 50 possible points

If there are not enough entries in each category, the judges will have the option of amalgamating two categories
